To Our Residents and Family Members:

As you know, information is coming in daily, even hourly, regarding COVID-19 Vaccines. Finally we have hopeful news! There are now two vaccinations that have been determined to be up to 95% effective in preventing the spread of COVID-19 approved by the FDA for administration. The other good news paired with this approval and distribution has been that the residents and tenants, along with our caregivers are among the first to receive the vaccinations. At this time, the information that we have:

- Our Pharmacy Partner will be Walgreens. They are currently working with communities to establish a plan and on-site clinic for administration.
- We have on-site vaccine coordinators
- We are being told we will receive the Moderna vaccine. We are including the Moderna Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) with this letter.
- Vaccinations will require a verbal or written consent by the resident/tenant or responsible party. We are including a copy of the Walgreens Consent form for your review. We will be contacting individual residents, tenants, POAs and other responsible parties to obtain required consents.
- Skilled Nursing resident and staff vaccines are expected to arrive and be distributed the week of December 28<sup>th</sup>.
- Assisted Living tenant and staff vaccines are expected to arrive in January, but a specific date has not been given at this time.

We understand that you are concerned about your loved one, and we are taking all the precautionary measures recommended to prevent the spread of COVID-19. The CDC and state health departments strongly **recommend against taking people who live in long-term care facilities to their homes or to gatherings for holiday events.** We know that family togetherness is especially important during the holidays, and we encourage you to contact us to arrange a virtual visit via FaceTime, Skype, etc.

As we celebrate the holidays we are also mindful of all we sacrificed and lost in 2020. Please watch our Facebook posts for updates on all our events.

We are grateful for your continued understanding of the ever changing information. All of us at Tealwood Senior Living send you wishes for peace and joy this holiday season.
